

Participant Release of Liability Form

The participation at the Race across Italy is the choice of the athletes as well as their crew members and it is therefore their own responsibility and at their own risk. The organizer (Asd Bike&Dreams) refuse any liability for athletes and their crew members, for any damage of contractual as well as of legal nature, as far as legally permitted. Furthermore the organizer are totally exempt from any liability for actions or negligence caused by services of third parties.

Equally excluded are liability claims from the athletes and their respective crew against organization helpers and volunteers. Liability insurance, insurance against accident, illness or theft from the athletes and his crewmembers are the sole responsibility of the athlete and his or her crewmembers.

The organizer cannot be held liable for any acts of God or events which in spite of every care having been taken, cannot be foreseen or avoided. If the race due to external influences, such as for example very bad weather conditions or an accident or cancelled at short notice has to be discontinued, there is no entitlement to a refund of start fees and/or damages. The decision of rejection and/or termination is at the sole decision of the organizer.

The Rules on website represent an integral part of this declaration. All team members (athletes and crew) hereby confirm having read, understood and accepted the Race Across Italy Rules which can be found on the website of the organizer (www.raceacrossitaly.com).
